Mr Ganley is the Chief of Readiness and Contingency Operations for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers - North Atlantic Division.

The North Atlantic Division is one of eight Corps of Engineers regions providing engineering and construction services to the nation. When called upon, the Corps also carries out missions assigned by FEMA following disasters as part of its responsibility for Emergency Support Function (ESF) #3 (public works and engineering) as outlined in the National Response Framework.

During the aftermath of Tropical Storms Irene and Lee, Mr. Ganley managed the North Atlantic Division contingency operations along the northeast from Virginia to Maine. Mr. Ganley also led the initial and follow-up ESF#3 response and recovery efforts in southwest Missouri, in Joplin and the surrounding communities, following the devastating F-5 tornado that struck there on 22 May 2011.
